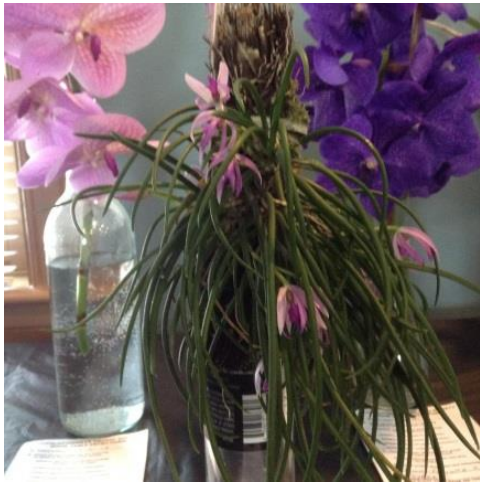

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE:

Our April CHAOS meeting is near (8 April 2018) Spring has arrived here in Central Virginia and that means that now is the best time for dividing and repotting our Winter blooming orchids. Soon it will be warm enough to begin taking our cool growing Dendrobiums and Cymbidiums outside for the warmer months. This is a good time to clean up those plants that have been relatively inaccessible during the Winter. Be sure to check for any pests that may have taken up residence during this period. A strong squirt with a hose will dislodge most of the critters once we can take the plants outside. If any bad infestations are found, treatment with your favorite insecticide may be in order. It is also time to increase fertilization as the growing season begins.

This meeting will be held at our usual location (1024 Carrington Place, our normal venue across Rio road from the Church of Our Savior). Setup will begin at the normal time (2:30) and the formal program will begin around 3:00. Remember that our raffle ticket price has been increased to \$1 per ticket and that the raffle plants will include some plants from the donated collection by Ms Naomi Itahi. Please feel free to bring snacks to share. Hope to see you at the meeting next Sunday.

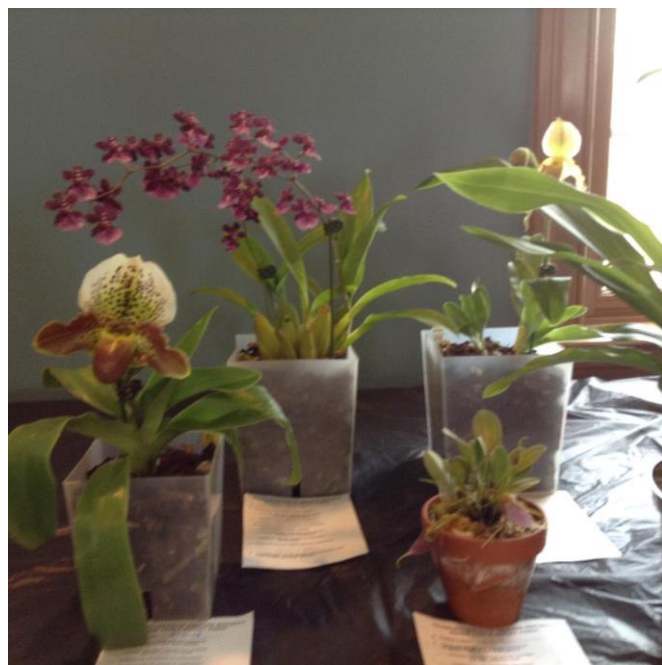
