Don't forget to check for bugs and treat them with some systemic insect control such as Bayer's Rose & Flower Care with Merit (Imidacloprid) as recommended by our speaker Keith Davis. Keith was very interesting but unfortunately we ran out of time before he could show us his tricks for planting specimen size orchids.
