PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE:

Although Summer's unusual weather patterns have persisted into the fall, it seems that cool temperatures will finally arrive to coincide with our next meeting which will be held on 14 October 2018. All of our warmth loving plants should be safely moved inside our homes and greenhouses by then. Our intermediate and cool growing plants may enjoy a few more weeks outside, especially those whose flowering seems to be triggered by those brisk cool mornings just prior to the first frost. Be careful to inspect your plants for stowaways as you bring them inside. Slugs and snails are great at hiding deep inside the potting medium only to emerge under cover of darkness as flowers unfurl. Their love of beer is their downfall. Other pests such as scale and mealy bugs may be dispensed with by a sharp stream from the garden hose, or an insecticide if the infestation warrants. This is a good time to apply systemic insecticides to our most problem plants..

I would also like to remind everyone that the election of officers for our society will take place at our November meeting. As I announced last month, I will be stepping down as President at the end of the year and I encourage candidates for the presidency or any of our other offices to make their intentions known at the October meeting.

Our meeting will be held at our usual meeting place (1024 Carrington Place, across Rio road from the Church of Our Savior) and time (3:00 pm). The room setup will begin at 2:30 and those bringing plants for our show table should arrive somewhat in advance of 3:00 so that judging of the show table can be completed prior to the start of our program. Please feel free to bring snacks to share. Hope to see you at the meeting on Sunday the 14th.
