Native orchid field trip

#### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE:

We have a busy schedule for May. In lieu of our regular meeting, we are going to take a field trip to Lanark Farm to view a colony of yellow ladyslippers in flower (and possibly other native orchids nearby). Our wildflower walk will be held on Sunday, May 1 and will be conducted by Lonnie Murray and Brian Morse. Lonnie is the Chair of the Albemarle County Natural Heritage Committee and a member of the Board of Directors of the Thomas Jefferson Soil and Water Conservation District. Brian is the Principal Wildlife Biologist for the Virginia Forestry and Wildlife Group (a forestry management company that Brian heads). Also assisting us will be Frank Coursey the farm manager for Lanark Farm. Frank has promised to provide a Gator vehicle (or pick-up truck) to allow our non-ambulatory members access to the site. The conservationist motto (take only photographs leave only footprints) is in effect. As always, be careful where you step.

The site is accessed by an easy 1/4 mile walk along a gently sloping forest road. Parking at the final destination is quite limited (5-6 cars) so we will need to meet at an alternate location (perhaps at the entrance to Lanark Farm) and carpool to the site. Lanark Farm is located on Carter's Mountain Road (between Morven Estate and Trump Winery). You may reach Lanark Farm by leaving Charlottesville via Rt 20 (toward Scottsville) and turning left on VA-53 (Thomas Jefferson Parkway just past the entrance to PVCC). Go past Monticello to the James Monroe Pkwy (passing Ash Lawn Highlands) and the James Monroe Parkwy becomes Carters Mountain Rd after 2.6 mi. Lanark Farm entrance is on the right (1.7 mi further) just before the entrance to Trump winery (Grand Cru Dr).

Let's plan to meet at the entrance to Lanark at 2:00 pm. From there we will carpool/caravan across Lanark to the forest road that provides access to the site. Please let me know via email (ldudleymiller@aim.com) or phone (home phone 434 823 7049; cell 434 996 2191) if you plan to attend so that we don't leave anyone behind (you will likely not be able to find the site if you miss the caravan). Finally, since this event is outside it is subject to cancellation due to weather. We will try to email you by noon on Sunday if the event has to be cancelled. A make-up field trip for May 15 (in another location) will be planned should cancellation of the 1 May event become necessary.

Last of all, remember that our orchid sale will be taking place at Tabor PC, Crozet, on 7,8 May (10:00 am -6:00 pm on Sat,; 12:00-6:00 Sun). We will have a show table as well as a sale table and show plants will be judged. Set-up is from 9:00-10:00 Sat. Other information about this event will be sent separately.
